Activities Week - Wednesday 13 - Friday 15 July

Pupils in years 8, 9 and 10 will be taken off normal timetable to take part in Activities week on the above dates. On Wednesday 13 July we will hold our first Pensby High School Sports Day. On Thursday 14 and Friday 15 July there will be an Arts Festival which will take the form of a number of exciting workshops in the areas of creative art, dance, music, drama, poetry, cookery and singing. We hope to give the pupils the opportunity to become involved in as many different workshops as possible over the two days with the result being a "Celebration" afternoon on Friday 15 July at 1.30pm. This will hopefully give the pupils an experience, which they will never forget!

We have invited artists from around Britain to take part in the festival which will have a multi-cultural theme based around the title of "Carnival". Workshops include: salsa dancing, samba music, African drumming, Chinese dance, batik, mural painting, sculpture etc. This is a very ambitious project, which will involve all pupils who are not taking part in school trips, and all activities will be undertaken in school within the normal school hours.

Although this is a voluntary contribution, if not enough contributions are received, some activities of the activities may have to be reduced in scale.
